


Chronic Abdominal Pain



Alarm Symptoms

- Involuntary weight loss or linear growth failure
- Delayed puberty
- Recurrent oral ulcers
- Joint symptoms
- Family history of IBD
- Unexplained fevers/rashes
- Dysphagia
- Chronic anemia of unknown etiology
- Leukocytosis or elevated inflammatory markers (ESR, CRP, PLTS)
- Hypoalbuminemia
- Jaundice/scleral icterus
- Perianal disease (skin tags, fissures)
- Persistent RUQ or RLQ pain
- Abdominal pain referring to back/shoulders
- Hepatosplenomegaly
- Localized fullness/mass effect
- Bilious emesis/hematemesis
- Recurrent emesis or cyclical vomiting
- Melena/Hematochezia
- GI bleed
- Chronic diarrhea (> 2 months)
