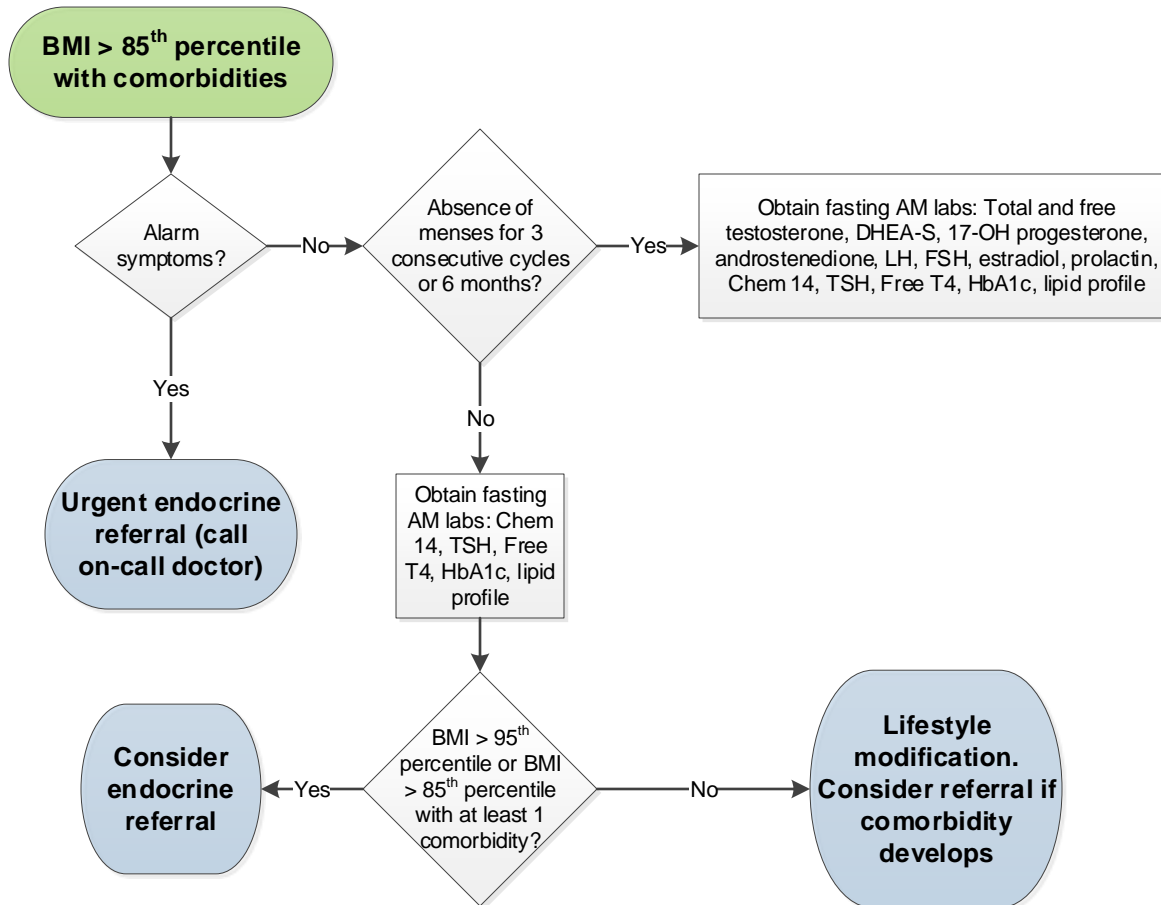


Obesity



- Alarm Symptoms**
- Abrupt onset
 - Decline in growth velocity
 - Severe or early morning headaches
 - Polyuria/polydipsia
 - Buffalo hump
 - Violaceous striae

- Comorbidities**
- T2DM (HbA1c \geq 6.5%, fasting BG \geq 126)
 - HbA1c \geq 5.7%, impaired fasting glucose (fasting BG 100-125), or impaired glucose tolerance (2 hour OGTT glucose 140-200)
 - Any elevation in AST and ALT
 - Dyslipidemia
 - Suspected Obstructive Sleep Apnea
 - PCOS (amenorrhea, signs of androgen excess – severe acne, hirsutism, deepening voice, polycystic ovaries) – female only
 - History of Slipped Capital Femoral Epiphysis or Blount disease
 - Hypertension
 - Prader-Willi Syndrome
